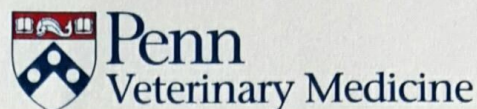



JDCM Linked Marker DNA Test Information

Test Pattern/Genotype: 1-2
Test Result: probable carrier **Test ID Number:** 7360
Type of Sample: Blood

Result Interpretation: 1-2 (probable carrier) dogs are not expected to develop JDCM, and are predicted to be carriers of JDCM. Due to the inherent nature of linked marker tests, there is a slight chance that a 1-2 dog is either normal (not a carrier), or will develop JDCM (see JDCM linked marker DNA test FAQ sheet at www.pwdca.org or www.pwdfoundation.org). There is a 50% chance that a carrier dog will pass the JDCM-causing gene to each offspring.
